## **Behaviour during the corona period from 20 April 2020**

### **Living in a boarding school**

The entire college is open to internal students, including all buildings, which may be entered and used in accordance with the boarding school regulations. Due to the complexity of the matter, special instructions regarding the number of users and, if necessary, the time and duration of use will be discussed individually with the boarding school management.

As long as restaurants and discotheques in Baden-Württemberg are closed, both the party cellar and the aquarium remain closed. After the opening of the public facilities, a mode for the reopening of the same at the college will be found.

As long as the public contact closures are in place (currently until 03.05.20), it is not allowed to leave the college premises without further notice. In case of doubt, please ask the boarding school management which open spaces and buildings belong to the college grounds. Exceptions to this rule are also to be requested from the boarding school management.

### **Meals in the boarding school**

The dining room allocation is made by the boarding school management, depending on how many students are currently in the boarding school. Meals are available in the dining rooms at the times indicated in the extraordinary boarding school rules. Depending on how many students are present, we will open additional dining rooms to avoid long, tight queues at the buffet.

For the time being, the food is distributed by staff of the college! No self-service! No students touch the food!

Please do not sit more than 3 students at one table (i.e. one free seat each).

### **Media in the boarding school**

All students of all ages are allowed to bring their own laptops, tablets, smartphones and generally keep them overnight.

If misuse is observed or if we have the impression that students prefer to chat or watch films during the night instead of sleeping, the boarding school management reserves the right to make a call and to confiscate the corresponding device for the time being and, if necessary, to hand it over for study purposes only.

### **Quarantine in the boarding school**

In accordance with the German regulations for students arriving from abroad, there are various groups at the college which are exclusively reserved for these students (so-called quarantine groups) and may not be entered by other students. Up to 14 days after arrival in Germany, the respective students live in these groups and take their meals in a separate dining room. There are separate educators who are exclusively responsible for these groups. The study and leisure program takes place separately from the other groups during this time - but it takes place!

#### **Attention!**

Those who arrive from abroad and want to participate in the possibly soon to be scheduled classes (presumably from May 4, 2020 for individual classes) must have been in Germany for 15 days at the time of the first class visit and must have been healthy during the entire time! We recommend all students whose main residence is not in Germany to consider this in good time and to organize a punctual return to the college if necessary! This applies especially to high school graduates! According to the current state of knowledge in Baden-Württemberg, the Abitur will be written from 18 May 2020! The latest date of entry to Germany to take the exam on May 18 would be May 03, 2020, but then without the possibility to attend classes again before.

### **Hygiene in the boarding school**

Before each meal, everyone washes their hands thoroughly! The same applies after each visit to the toilet. We have enough sinks and soap in the college! We will talk separately about wearing mouthguards here.

### **Sick in the boarding school**

We measure more fevers and pay more attention to each other. As soon as someone feels ill (not only with regard to influenza or Covid-19), please stay in your own room and call an educator, who will then take appropriate action. We are in close and constant contact with the Waldshut Health Department and Waldshut Hospital. In addition, our own infirmary is open again on schedule and our family doctors are making house calls again. If necessary, our infirmary can be extended with a variety of beds in other parts of the Kolleg.
